1. Eligibility: All ponies/ cobs/half-welsh must be registered with the Welsh Pony & Cob Society of America, Inc. the WPCS, the WPCSC, or, if under one year, be eligible for registration. Only animals registered with the Welsh Pony Cob Society of America, Inc. will receive points. All animals must be shown under their full registered name & number. Before an animal is assigned a number or enters the ring for competition, the show secretary must have a copy of the Welsh Certificate of Registration in the current owner's name and a current Coggins test, when required. If the animal is under one year and not yet registered, submit a copy of the dam's Certificate of registration, the registration number and name of the sire and the proposed name of the entry. Unnamed foals may not be shown. A breeding pony may not show in both Section A and Section B classes, nor may a cob be shown in both section C and Section D classes during the same year. All lease agreements must be officially recorded through the Society office. All recorded leases are designated as such on animal's Certificate of Registration. Leased animals being shown must present a copy of the registration listing the lessee.

2. Measurement: All hater ponies 6 years and over all performance animals must present a copy of a WPCSA or USEF permanent measurement card or measurement conducted during the current year of completion, or be measured. Measurement before show starts.

3. Entries: Copy of BOTH SIDES of the Registration Papers MUST accompany each entry. If you have a current measurement card, please include a copy of it. Exhibitor's numbers will not be assigned until ALL paperwork is completed, PLEASE take the time to fill out your entry form completely.

4. SAFETY FIRST: The safety of our exhibitors, their animals, and the public is our highest concern. Please keep your animals under control at all times and do not put them in dangerous situations. Be especially mindful of children, either inside or outside the show ring. **For animals in harness, animals must be fully bridled while hitching and unhitching. Removing the bridle from an animal harnessed to a vehicle, or leaving an animal unattended while hitched anywhere on the show grounds will result in the instant elimination and removal from the show grounds.**

5. Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times whenever mounted or in a driven vehicle at all times while on the show ground. Harness must be secured and properly fitted. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is in place.

6. All riders in any class where jumping is required and/or when jumping anywhere on the grounds, MUST wear protective headgear. All Junior riders riding in Hunters must wear properly fitted headgear with chin harness secured, while riding anywhere on the grounds. Anyone violating this rule will be prohibited from further riding until in compliance. All junior riders are encouraged to wear properly fitted headgear with chin harness secured, while riding anywhere on the grounds whether riding English or Western style.

7. Stakes Classes: To qualify for entry, exhibitor must enter and compete in at least one other class in that division.

8. Post Entry: Entries not received by April 12, 2008 will be charged a post entry fee of \$ 5.00 per class.

8. NO dogs, per Mar Val's Insurance.

9. Juniors are not allowed to show stallions.

10. Division Championship: In case of a tie (except Hunters) it shall be settled by the flip of a coin. In case of a tie in hunters, the championship or reserve will be awarded to the animal that accumulated the most points over fences. If animals have an equal number of points over fences, they must be shown at a walk, trot, and canter using the same judging specifications as in the classes offered in the division. No championship points will be awarded in any division unless all three classes are held and have at least three entries per class. Points for championship shall be calculated as follows: 1st = 5 pts, 2nd = 3 pts, 3rd = 2 pts, 4th = 1 pt.

11. Payment of fees: A check must be received with the entry for the full amount calculated on entry form. Returned checks will be subject to a \$ 25 fee and must be cleared with 30 days of the show or disciplinary action will be sought with WPCSA. No refunds will be given unless a class is canceled or upon receipt of a Vet Certificate or Doctor's Note. The show management's discretion shall be used in other instances. Decisions of show management is FINAL.

12. Any abuse towards an animal, child or show official, or show management shall be cause for immediate ejection from the show grounds without refund.

13. Management: reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entries, or disqualify riders.

14. Courses will be available at the entry booth and shall be posted at least one hour prior to the scheduled performance time.

15. Two Minute gate will be strictly enforced. An additional 3 minutes shall be allowed for requested tack change. The gate will not be held for more than five minutes.

16. Stabling: Pens only available @ \$15/night. **Food:** There will be food available on grounds.

WPCSA BREED CLASSES(Article 110.2)

Animals are to be shown in hand at a walk and a trot except in group classes. Purebred Welsh to be judged 85% on breed type, conformation, **way of going, quality and substance and 15% on disposition and manners. Natural reaching action is desired. Half-Welsh to be judged 85% on conformation, way of going, quality and substance and 15% on Welsh breed type, disposition and manners.**

WPCSA WELSH ENGLISH PLEASURE (Article 112.3)

To be shown at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring on light contact without martingale. To be judged 75% on performance, manners movement and style; 25 % on breed type and conformation. Working class to be judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA WELSH HUNTER (Article 112.5)

Over fences(o/f): To be shown over a course of a minimum of eight fences of the required height. To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% on breed type and conformation. Working classes judged 100% on performance. Animals not exceeding 13.2 hands will jump 2'0", animals exceeding 13.2 but not over 14.2 hands shall jump 2'6". Animals exceeding 14.2 hands jump 2'9". Under saddle(u/s): To be eligible, pony must have shown in and completed an over fence class. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. **May be required to gallop one way of the ring, but no more than eight animals at one time.**

WPCSA SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER (Article 112.6)

Division is open to riders 12 years and under. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Riders in this division may not compete over fences in any other division except short Stirrup equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences with 8 jumping efforts required. May either trot or canter the entire course. Over-fence classes must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance. To be eligible for the under-saddle class, pony must be entered and complete a course in at least one over-fence class. Under-saddle class animals shown both ways of ring at a walk, trot and canter.

WPCSA PLEASURE DRIVING (Article 113.1)

To be shown to a suitable two or four-wheeled vehicle or four-wheeled vehicle for pairs, but not a viceroy, racing sulky or fine harness rig. To be shown both ways of the ring at a walk, working trot and trot on and stand quietly and except for tandems, **to back readily.** To be judged 75% on performance, manners, movement and style; 25% breed type and conformation. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA CARRIAGE DRIVING (Article 113.2)

In addition to the gaits detailed in the pleasure driving section (Article 113.1), carriage driving also requires the slow trot which is slower and more collected but not to the degree required in the dressage collected trot. The animal should indicate a willingness to be driven on the bit while maintaining a steady cadence. Turnout to be judged 40% on performance, manners and way of going; 30% on the condition, fit and appropriateness of harness and vehicle; 15% on neatness and appropriateness of attire; and 15% on overall impression. Working class to be judged 70% on performance, manners and way of going; 20% on condition and fit of harness and vehicle; 10% on neatness of attire. Obstacle/Cones to be Judged 100% on performance. Rules for obstacle/cones need to be added to prize list.

WPCSA LEADING REIN (Article 115.1)

Section A, B, C or Half-Welsh, mare or gelding, 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but not more than eight, years of age. Ponies to be judged on manners, suitability, breed type, conformation and turn-out. This is not an equitation class.

WPCSA CHILD'S FIRST PONY (Article 115.2)

Section A, B, C and Half-Welsh, mare or gelding 12.2 hands and under, to be ridden by junior exhibitors at least four, but no more than 10, years of age. Riders to be suitably dressed in Hunt, Saddle or Western attire including protective headgear. Ponies to be shown at a walk and trot or jog, both ways of the ring. Ponies to be judged on performance, manners and suitability. Conformation, way of going, and turnout to be emphasized. This is not an equitation class.

WPCSA LEADLINE WALK (Article 115.4)

Classes open to riders 7 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount at a walk. To stand quietly. To be led by an adult or a junior age 12 or over. Both handler and rider to be appropriately attired. English or Western attire is acceptable. No chain leadlines. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, leadline walk-trot, and leadline walk-trot poles.

WPCSA WALK (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk-trot, walk-trot poles. To walk both ways of the ring.

WPCSA WALK-TROT (Article 115.5)

Classes open to riders 11 & under mounted on ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. Judged on equitation and suitability of mount. To walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring. Possible test to include: walk, trot/jog, turn, halt and rein back at spots marked. English or Western attire is acceptable. Riders ineligible for other ridden classes except costume, leading rein, child's first pony, walk, walk-trot poles.

WPCSA SHOWMANSHIP (Article 115.6)

Classes should be offered for exhibitors 12 & under and 13-17 years of age. Judged on presentation and showman's ability to show his/her pony/cob. 40% of the judging is on neatness and appearance of the showman, pony and tack. 60% will be based on the exhibitor's ability to present his/her pony/cob. Exhibitor's will be informed of the judges choice of pattern to be used, before entering the ring.

WPCSA WELSH WESTERN PLEASURE (Article 112.4)

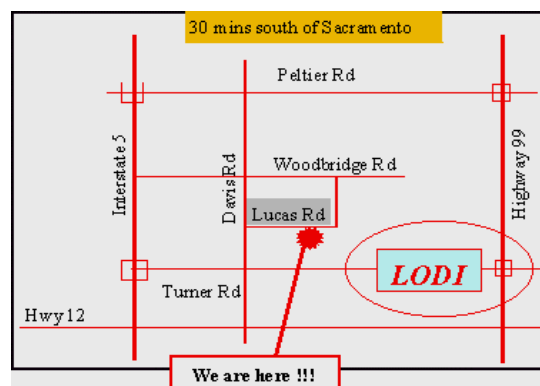
To be shown at a walk, jog and lope both ways of the ring without martingale on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. To be judged on performance, with emphasis on manners 65%; breed type, movement and conformation 25%; appointments 10%. Working classes are judged 100% on performance.

WPCSA TRAIL (Article 115.3)

English or Western equipment. Open to all ponies/cobs/half-Welsh. To be shown over and through obstacles at a walk, optional trot or jog and optional canter or lope. To be judged 100% on performance. Juniors will not side pass or lope/canter over loose rails.

WPCSA LONG STIRRUP HUNTER (Article 116.1) **

Division is open to riders 13 to 17 and 18 and over. Classes are open to all ponies/cobs half-Welsh. Riders in this division may not compete over fences in any other division except long stirrup equitation. Courses to be set at 18" with a minimum of 4 fences and eight jumping efforts required. Over-fence class must precede the under-saddle class. To be judged 100% on performance
