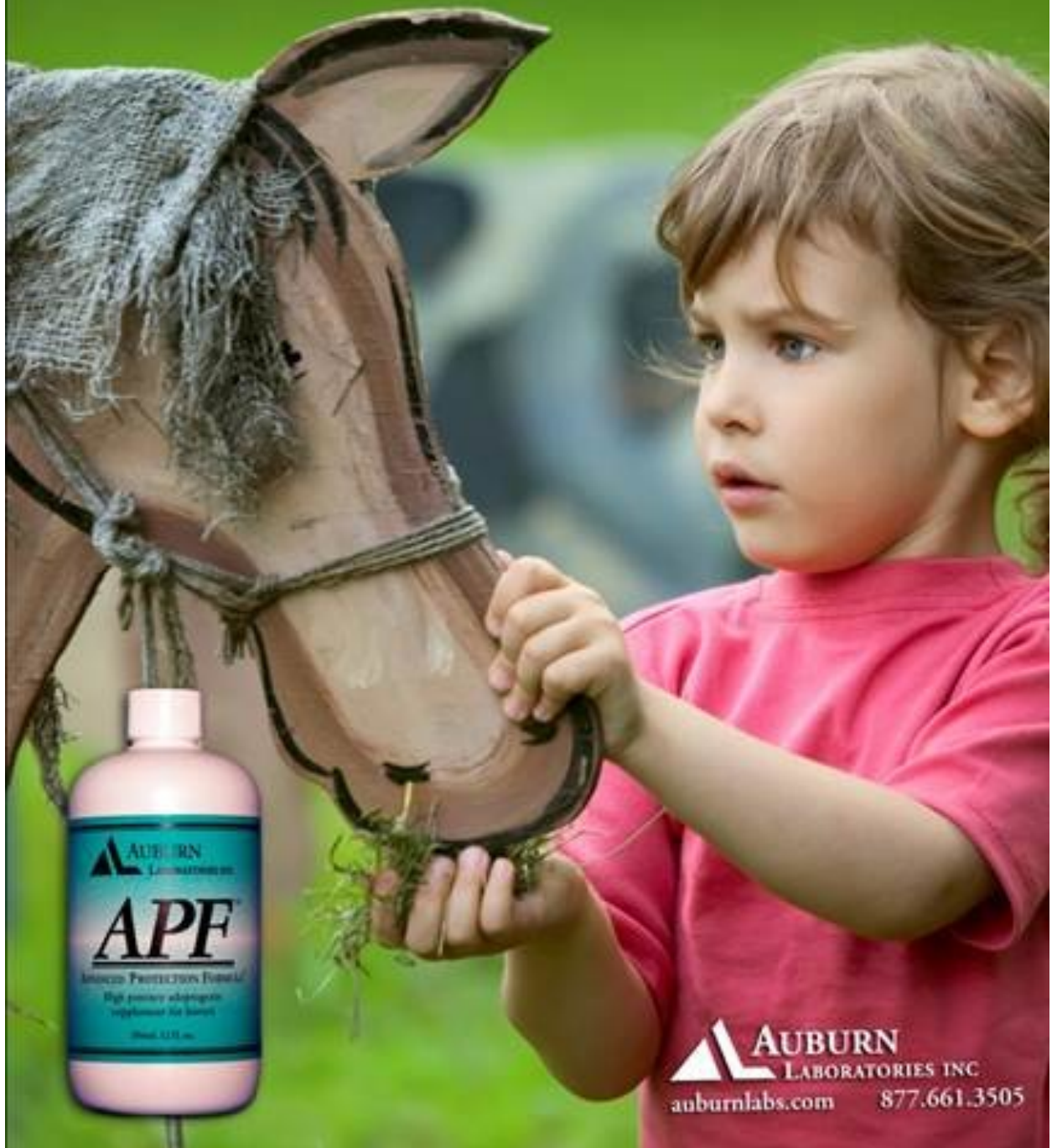

DEFINITIONS OF MEMBERSHIP TYPE

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP: Categories are Farm, Family, Single or Junior. Regular Member is a resident of California or Nevada and who is the owner or lessee of a Registered Welsh Pony/Cob and is eligible for one of the following memberships:

FARM: Ponies/Cobs owned by Farm members who elect this membership will earn pony points for year-end high point awards regardless of the membership status of the exhibitor. However, equitation division points and points for pony/cob & rider combinations divisions must be earned by WPCAC members for points to count. Farm members will be entitled to two votes, one vote per adult member.

FAMILY: family members are the parents or guardians and all the children under the age of 18 years living in the same household with such parent/s or guardian/s who are elected to membership. A family membership shall be entitled to one vote per parent/guardian (limit two). Children under 18 years of age shall be designated Junior Members.

SINGLE: over 18 years of age, and the owner or lessee of a Registered Welsh Pony/Cob. A single membership is entitled to one vote.

JUNIOR: Junior members are those persons under the age of 18. They shall have a voice, but no vote. (Junior members without a pony will be Associate members)

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP: Associate members are owners or non-owners of Welsh Ponies residing outside of California and Nevada or people who reside in California and Nevada but do not own a registered Welsh Pony/Cob, yet are interested in furthering the purpose of the Association. Associate members shall have all rights, privileges and responsibilities of regular members, except the right to vote and hold office. Associates are not Regular Members.

Associate members are eligible for the following memberships:

ASSOCIATE FARM: Ponies/Cobs owned by Farm members who elect this membership will earn pony points for year-end high point awards regardless of the membership status of the exhibitor. However, equitation division points and points for pony/cob & rider combinations divisions must be earned by WPCAC members for points to count.

ASSOCIATE FAMILY: Family members (parents or guardians) and dependent children under the age of 18 years living in the same household.

ASSOCIATE SINGLE: Individual membership of adult or junior.

Please enroll me in an Achievement Award Program:

ACHIEVEMENT AWARD: Presented to Registered Welsh Ponies/Cobs/Half-Welsh who participate in three (3) different non-WPCAC sanctioned events including: open shows, parades, clinics, demonstrations, pleasure drives, trail riding or driving, etc. Owners will be sent an Official Trail Log Book, event forms and rules. Awards are given to the animals. Exhibitors must be members of WPCAC. On completion the first year participants will receive a framed certificate and official WPCAC seal.

Fee: \$20/pony. On completion receive an award and official WPCAC seal.

\$5/pony. On completion receive only official WPCAC seal.

JUNIOR MEMBER ACHIEVEMENT AWARD: Presented to WPCAC Junior Members who participate in three (3) different non-WPCAC sanctioned events including: open shows, parades, clinics, demonstrations, pleasure drives, trail riding or driving, writing articles, etc. Junior members will be sent an Official Trail Log Book, event forms and rules. Awards are given to the Junior Member.
